OPENING OCULUS QUEST 2 BOX

First, remove the plastic wrap from the box by pulling the tab. When you open the box's cover, you'll find the following items inside:

Oculus Quest 2 headset
Silicone cover
Two touch controllers
Two AA batteries, already inserted in the controllers
A charging cable and power adapter
A spacer for those who wear glasses
Reference materials

To activate the controllers, pull out the plastic tab on the bottom of the devices. Also, remove the L and R stickers from the controllers and the plastic holding the wrist straps.

Then, pull the tab (on the right side of your headset) near the power button to remove the wrapping. Where your face goes into the headset, you'll find the optional silicone cover and another insert that explains how to adjust the lenses. Simply remove them along with the protective plastic.

ADJUSTING THE QUEST 2 HEADSET

To turn your headset on, press and hold the Power button on the right side for a few seconds. Test the fit by pulling the strap back and placing it over your head.

To make adjustments, remove the headset, then use the two sliders on the back of the strap to adjust how tightly it fits. Move the sliders towards the center strap to loosen it or towards the outside of the headset to tighten it.

Place the headset back on once you've found a good fit.

Now you can adjust the top strap so that it fits comfortably.

Remove the Velcro from the upper strap.

Once the headset is powered on, you'll see the initial setup screen, which walks you through picking up the controllers and connecting to your Wi-Fi network, followed by a short informational video.



If the screen appears blurry, remove the headset and move the lenses closer together or apart to check if this improves vision. You will be able to make minor adjustments to the headset once you put it on. Be sure it is not too high or low.

After this, your Oculus Quest 2 will need to install the newest software update. At this point, you'll be able to take your headset off and plug it in to charge.

INSTALLING & CONFIGURING THE OCULUS APP

As you wait for your headset to update, you should download the Oculus app for Android or iOS.

Oculus requires a Facebook account, so you will need to sign in to your Facebook profile or create one if you do not already have one. Additionally, if you have a legacy Oculus account, you can connect it.

After you sign in, the app will ask you to set up your VR username and profile photo to connect with others. Use an image from your Facebook album, a photo from your phone, or choose one from the defaults.







The app shows your Facebook friends that use Oculus on the next screen. Simply tap Add Friend to add someone on the platform.

Now, choose who can see your Oculus activity and who can see your Facebook name when you're using Oculus. Choose from Public, Friends, or Only me. Select your interests on the next page so that Oculus can make better suggestions for you.

The next step is to create a PIN that protects purchases on the Oculus Store. To purchase items, you can either add a credit card or PayPal account or skip this step for now.

The Oculus headset is now ready to be paired with the app. Select your model from the list that appears, and the app should detect your Oculus automatically. Put your headset back on to finish the setup.

The final step in your Oculus Quest 2 initialization is to set up Guardian. A safety feature on the Oculus lets you mark the area where you should move around without being harmed. If you attempt to move past the marked area, it will alert you.

This is vital if you play in room-scale mode; it's not necessary if you play in stationary mode. For room-scale, Oculus recommends a space that's 6.5 feet by 6.5 feet at least.

Move to the area where you will use your Oculus if you have not already done so. As part of this process, your Oculus will use Passthrough mode, allowing you to see a black-and-white feed of what's around you.

You can adjust your floor height by gently touching your controller to the ground.

Next, draw a safety line around the perimeter of your play area using the trigger on your controller. Leave enough room around obstacles, such as walls and furniture. It might be 胡椒 cult to realize you have crossed the border until it is too late if you put the border right up against something.

The next step is to create a PIN that protects purchases on the Oculus Store. To purchase items, you can either add a credit card or PayPal account or skip this step for now.

The guardian will then display wireframe walls that show the border you have set. When you get close to a boundary, it will turn red to warn you.

If you move to a new area, you must complete the guard ian setup process again. The headset remembers previous guardian areas, so you won't need to set it up again if you return to the original location.

HOFAVERSE EXPERIENCE ON OCULUS

The hard part is done now, and you are ready to have a VR-All-Art experience on Oculus Quest 2.

Join via mobile and desktop / web app https://player.vrallart.com/exhibition/dao

You can access the universal menu by pressing the Oculus button on the right controller at any time. You'll find icons for the main features of your device there.



Select the time and battery icons on the left side to open Quick Settings. Tap your profile icon to view and customize your user profile.



Next, press the Apps button and go to Search Apps with your right controller. In the Search Apps tab, type VR-All-Art and download the app. It is necessary to be online and connected to the internet to download the VR-All-Art application.



After entering the VR-All-Art app, you will see a welcome note in front of you.



In case you do not yet have an account, the next step is to register and verify your email address with VR-All-Art or enter the e-mail address and password provided by the VR-All-Art team. As soon as your email address has been confirmed, you can begin the VR-ALL-Art experience!



The first step is to go to My Profile and rename your avatar.

You can configure your avatar's appearance by going to

My Avatar and selecting the features that suit your needs best.



Click on the exhibition you wish to enter after the popup appears, then click ENTER EXHIBITION.



When you enter a VR exhibition, you can move through the gallery with your controller by pointing & clicking on the floor




To view additional information about an artwork or start a VR video, simply point and click on the artwork.



If you want to see another exhibition featured on VR-All-Art, look down on the floor, and the MENU icon will appear.

Next, click on the MENU, and once a popup appears, click on the icon Back to Home button, then choose the exhibition you want to see.
